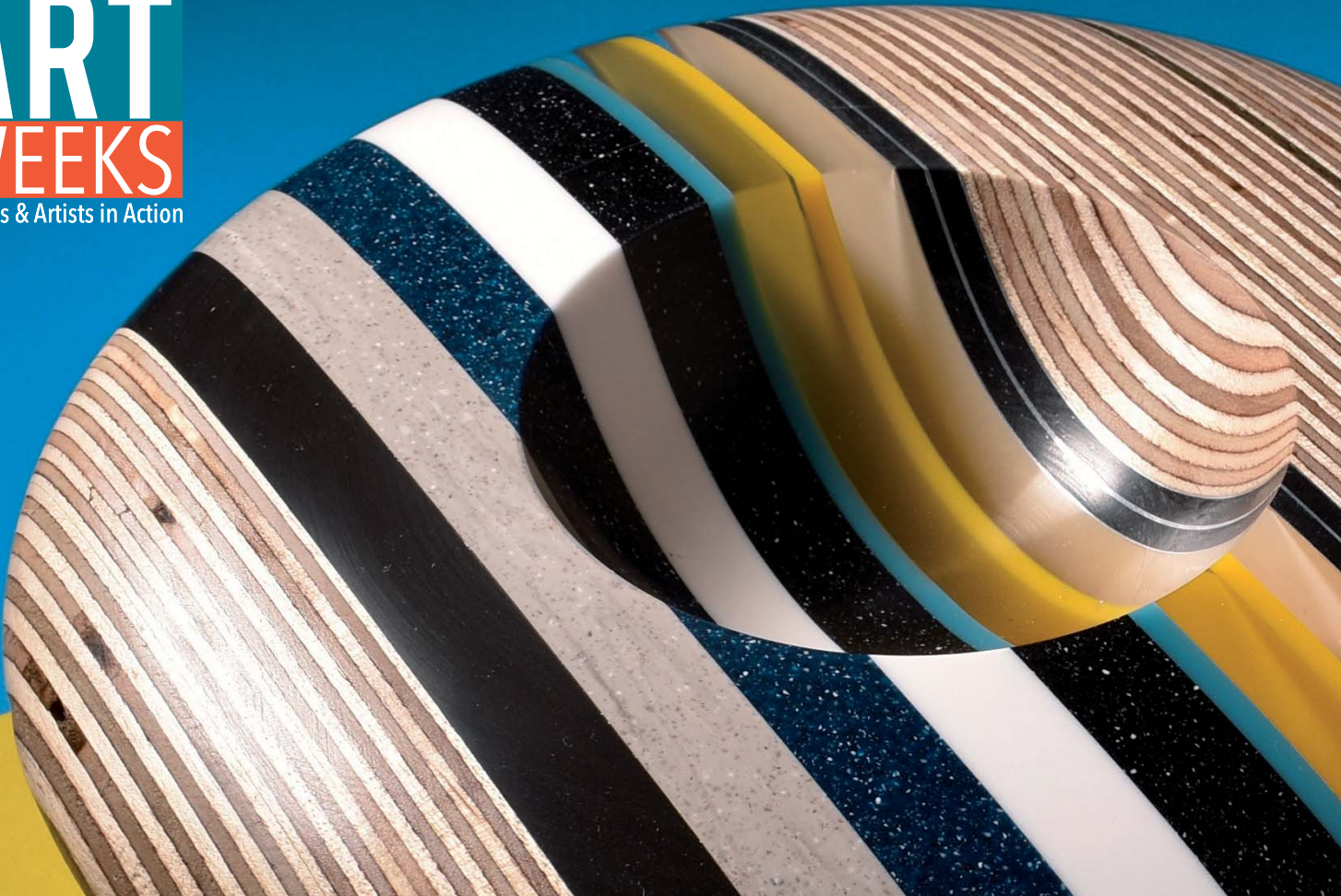


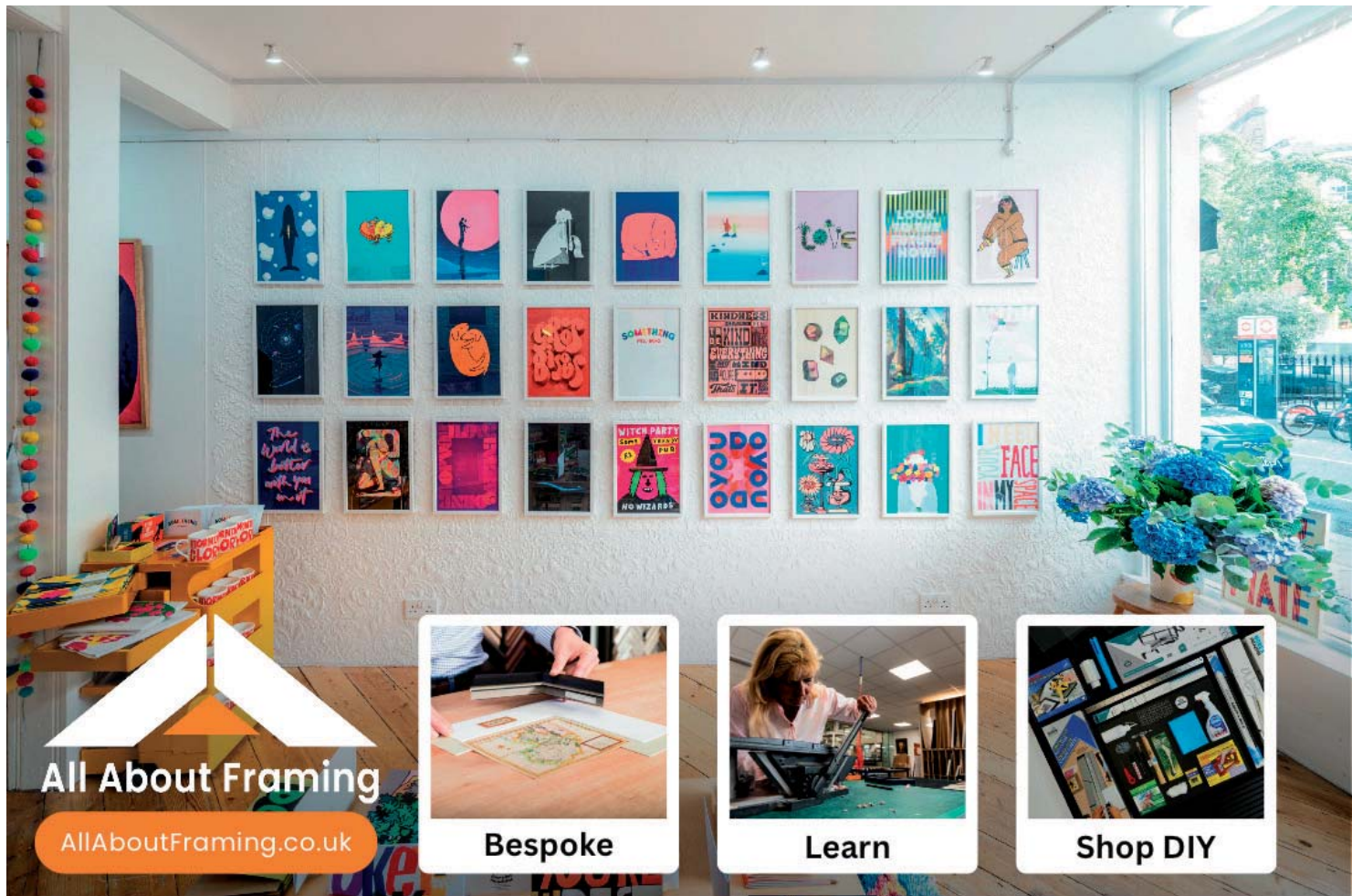

Welcome to Bucks Art Weeks 2025

As we celebrate the 40th anniversary of the Visual Images Group and the 40th Bucks Art Weeks, we focus on the organisers and participating artists who have built the event into a major part of the county's annual cultural offering.

Many members of the committee went nameless in past directories, but rather like the rings within a tree trunk, their hard work is recorded in the steady growth of Bucks Art Weeks' success.

This achievement has also been recognised by the Outstanding Contribution trophy, awarded by Buckinghamshire Culture Sparks Awards last year, and which I collected from Countess Howe (pictured right) on behalf of Bucks Art Weeks and all the members of the Visual Images Group.



One of the challenges from past years was balancing the event across all areas of Bucks, from Olney in the north to Burnham in the south. In the 1980s there were 60 members of the Visual Images Group, as opposed to over 400 in four regions today.


How to use this directory

40 years OF ART IN BUCKS

The late Shaun Hennessy from Milton Keynes was the original spokesman for the Visual Images Group when it was established in 1985. He helped set up the first event, which was held in June 1986, making this our 40th Bucks Art Weeks.

It's impossible to do justice to the hundreds of people who have been involved behind the scenes over the last four decades, working to build this event into a major part of the Bucks cultural calendar, often voluntarily and without accolade.

Here we focus on four people, from four different regions, with four art specialities, all having played an important part in this wonderful event over the years.



Olney North Bucks

Deborah Hopson-Wolpe has been an exhibiting artist and maker with Bucks Art Weeks since its inception. She created the directory cover in 1990 using a striking and very recognisable lettering design that continued to be used for well over a decade. This was based on the typeface 'Albertus' that was designed by her father, the typographer Berthold Wolpe OBE.

After studying at Camberwell School of Art and living for a while in Japan, Deborah set up the Olney Pottery in 1975 and expanded into print making in 2006. Her working studio boasts a beautiful old Albion Press. During Bucks Art Weeks she shows pots (often with lettering), prints and greetings cards.



Stoke Mandeville The Vale of Aylesbury

A huge supporter and advocate of Bucks Art Weeks and the event's coordinator for over a decade, Trisha Woodcock has run Obsidian Art since 2002, and also directs the Buckinghamshire Craft Guild next door.

The greatest challenge that her team faced during the Open Studios era was a change in funding. The old County Council and four District Councils of Buckinghamshire used to finance a large part of the event. As this was gradually withdrawn, there was a drive towards self-funding through participation from many large art groups, and via advertising within the iconic yellow directory of those times.

Now Trisha's biggest challenge is the arrival of HS2, right through the valley alongside her gallery. With consolidation at Obsidian she has given herself time to focus on new art events at the Tudor farmhouse where she lives in peaceful Swanbourne. Trisha's art trail will bring 25 exhibitors to Art Weeks this year.

Monks Risborough Chilterns and the Thames Valley

Kate Wilkinson was part of a strong team that changed the Art Weeks directory design in 2015. The horizontal A5 format, perfect bound with a spine and high quality paper set new standards, and Kate pioneered the use of photo shoots to create cover montages of several artists' work.

Then in 2018 the team introduced new branding, a relaunched website and logo, with the word 'Art' back to its rightful place front and centre. The working studio icon was introduced to remind people of the original concept and ethos of open studios.

Kate is a jeweller who has taken part in many of the Visual Images Group events over the years, including '100 Women Artists' at Claydon House and art exhibitions at Stowe Gardens and Milton Keynes, as well as Bucks Art Weeks.

Chesham Chilterns and South Bucks

Our cover artist, Graham Lester, first exhibited paper sculpture at his home studio in Chesham following retirement from a design agency. Then, following a county-wide trend, he strengthened his position by joining with a group of exhibitors and becoming part of an art trail.

Graham now works with materials such as corian, acrylic and wood bonded together and turned to make beautiful upcycled bowls and pots, as illustrated. He finds it satisfying to make something beautiful from discarded items.

Within the county, his work can be found at Aylesbury Museum Café, the Buckinghamshire Craft Guild and The Good Earth Gallery, but Bucks Art Weeks at St Dunstons remains his biggest selling event of the year.

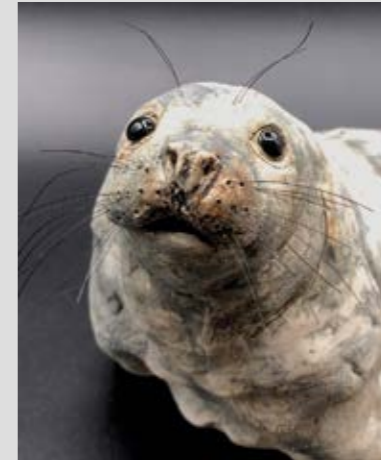

I'm delighted to have this opportunity to exhibit alongside eight other artists, covering a huge range of specialities. Lots to see and talk about in a lovely warm and welcoming atmosphere throughout the house and spacious garden. Refreshments available, with proceeds going to Willen Hospice.

Anna creates textile artwork inspired by a sense of place, using cloth, paper, mixed media and stitch. Interpreting observations of rural and urban landscapes using surface design processes such as printing, image transfer and paper lamination, Anna's work is driven by texture, pattern and colour.

Whimsical glazed ceramic sculpture, large and small. Made from combinations of thrown and handbuilt elements, inspired by nature and architectural forms. Also functional pots in stoneware and porcelain. Nine artists exhibiting in a designed garden and lovely home. Easy parking and refreshments.

Creating animal and wildlife art mostly in oils. Some work incorporates re-purposed vintage music, thereby adding to the story of the painting. Each work is inspired by emotional connections to the precious lives we share our time and planet with, and by music which can bring memories to mind.

Impressionistic and colourful townscape and still life paintings in oil. Original paintings, prints and greeting cards for sale. In this group exhibition, the artwork is displayed in several ground floor rooms and in the lovely garden. Drinks and cake available.

Individual hand built stoneware ceramic sculptures and garden pieces. A major interest is in shape and form, and how a simple shape can be developed in many ways. Current work explores stone shapes and geology (including flint) and that has included a greater emphasis on colour and texture.

I will be exhibiting my landscape paintings at my home with 8 other artists. I have a love of the outside world and to paint en plein air to capture the countryside around Stony Stratford. As a garden designer, I have an eye for composition and design in my paintings as well as in our large garden.

After setting up a studio in her home, Nichola is now enjoying celebrating a lifetime of collecting interesting things. Her still life work, capturing contrasting objects, starts with bold graphic lines and mark making. Colour is added using acrylics, chalk, ink and, most recently, collage.

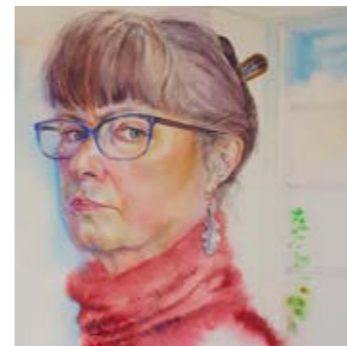

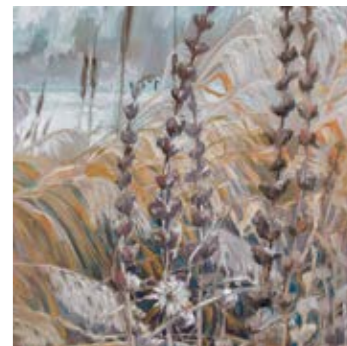

Sam creates contemporary glass art inspired by her love of the natural world. She likes to add colour & texture to her glass art, often creating pieces that evoke fond memories of favourite places. Please check Sam's website to see when she will be at the venue.

Join us at Leckhampstead Village Hall to enjoy original work by seven artists – classically inspired and contemporary oil painting, vibrant acrylics, decorative hanging ornaments, hand-pulled linocut printing, handcrafted sterling silver jewellery, and unique hand-woven textile designs.

For Asya, her cultural heritage created a treasury of visual imagery in terms of subject matter, colour and form, from which she draws her inspiration. Her artistic interests are wide ranging, creating figurative sculptures, paintings, and engaging 3D reliefs, exploring favourite themes and motifs.

Inspired by architecture, my work is about the elements & memory of built environments. I work with watercolours, pen, & photographs, & aim to fuse the qualities of painting with the spatial essence of architecture, creating compositions that invite viewers to experience what lies beyond the images.

I make mostly portraits and figure studies from life in the form of drawings, paintings and sculpture with a narrative. I'm a member of Artist Collective @ Westbury. Find me in Studio 6 on the ground floor of the Jacobean Farmhouse at Westbury Arts Centre. Entrance is 1st left off Foxcovert Rd.

Tapestry weaving is an ancient form of textile art. Woven by hand, using bundles of wool and gradually building from the bottom up, a tapestry can take many months to complete and is a mindful experience. My cues are the beauty, form, and colour of the natural world.

I draw and paint using oil, pastel, and charcoal. You can browse a body of work covering nearly 20 years as a studio holder at Westbury Arts Centre, as well as watching me at work.

I look forward to welcoming you to my studio, where you can browse a range of portraits, paintings, and drawings, primarily made with pastel, charcoal, watercolour, and oil.

Alison designs and makes unique and interesting pieces using the ancient technique of chainmaille, and its modern variant, scalamaille, linking rings into other rings in a range of weaves. These techniques create beautiful statement pieces and eye-catching accessories.

The stunning beauty of flowers, both whilst vibrantly alive and in their demise, have been a fascination for me for 50 years. In the last few years, watercolours have been my primary illustrating medium showing their transparency, delicacy and glory.

I am a specialist hand stitcher and tutor, working with leather, textiles, and digital art. One of a group in Kingsey Church. Lots of free parking and refreshments. Follow the signs to the car park on entering the village.

My art is a representation of what I see in my mind rather than an exact image of what I actually see. I love to explore the endless possibilities of working in glass. Nothing beats the anticipation of opening the kiln to see a new creation. I make fused glass artworks and stained glass.
